



Ruger MK IV Extended Magazine Bumper (Base Pad) Installation Instructions

Attention:

Before you begin be certain that the magazine is clear and safe. You will need a small punch, allen wrench, or awl for the installation process. Be cautious of the spring and wear safety glasses.

1. Locate the plunger at the base of the magazine.



2. Using an Allen wrench, or a similar tool, depress the plunger.



3. While the plunger is depressed, gently push the back of magazine base forward. **Be aware: the plunger is under spring tension and should be kept under tension if able.**

4. If unable to keep the spring depressed, you can feed the spring back into the magazine body by guiding the coils down.



5. With the spring and plunger fully in the magazine body, depress the plunger with the back of the magazine bumper base pad.



6. With the base pad in position, push it rearwards to slide it in place. You should hear a soft click.

If you find your spring isn't compressing into the hole as it should, use a 3/16 drill bit to clear it out.
